But if it shall happen my said sonne shall dye before attaining the said age then and in such case I give and bequeath the said third part of my Estate intended my said sonne unto my dear and loving wife Elizabeth my Executrix herein after named Item I doe remitt and forgive unto Mary Cludley widow the debt of five pounds which she oweth me The Remainder Next and Residue of all and every my goods Chattells money Plate debts and Estate whatsoever afore-mentioned I wholly give devise and bequeath unto my said dear and loving wife Elizabeth whom I doe ordaine and make the full and only Executrix of this my last will and Testament not doubting but she will performe the same according to my intent herein expressed And I desire my loving friends M^r William Meade and M^r John Hunter to be overseers of this my will and to assist my Executrix in the Execution thereof the best they can In witness whereof I the said Joshua Tenant the Testator to this my last will and Testament have written in one whole sheet and this part of another sheet of Paper joined together and sealed all the Topp have sett my hand and Seal Dated the eighteenth day of March Anno Domini 1673. And in the Six and Twentieth yeare of the Reigne of our Sovereign Lord King Charles the Second of England &c. Joshua Tenant. Signed Sealed and published and delivered by the said Testator for and as his last will and Testament the day of the date in the presence of Tho: Sturmer Bartho: Hunt Sr on Snow Hill.

 same for his will And that he was at all the premises of and in
 his perfect mind memory and understanding George Knight Elizabeth
 Knight her marke /
