I Philipp Dinarde of London and Dunt Cooper being at this present time  
 weak in body but of sound and good memory and understanding praised  
 be Almighty God for his sake and all other his mercies he hath in his  
 great Goodness vouchsafed to me do herefore make this my last Will  
 and Testament as followeth that is to say In the first place I commit  
 my soule into the hands of Almighty God my heavenly Father  
 believing that through his mercy and the merits of his only Sonne  
 Jesus Christ blessed Saviour and Redeemer I shall have all my sinnes  
 pardoned in this life and be made partaker of eternall happiness in the  
 life to come and my body I commit to the Earth wherof it was  
 formed to be decently interred at the discretion of my Executors herein  
 after named And as for that temporall Estate and worldly substance  
 wherewith Almighty God of his mercy hath entrusted me and left at my  
 disposal my just debts and funerall Charges being first paid I give  
 devise and bequeath the same as followeth I give and devise to  
 my loving brother William Dinarde and to my loving sister Mary  
 Dinarde the summe of first Shillings apiece in token of my love And  
 whereas my said brother William Dinarde now justly oweth to me the  
 summe of Thirty and Eight pounds of lawfull money of England  
 I now do hereby give and acquit to my said loving brother all the  
 interest due to me for the said money and as for the said principall  
 summe of Thirty and eight pounds soe due to me I Will and appoint  
 that the same be paid to my said Executor herein after named and  
 that my said Executor shall and doe pay and lay out to or for my  
 nephew Bartholomew Dinarde one Shilling hereof at such time and  
 in such manner as my said Executor only shall thinke  
 most fitting for my said nephew Good and Benefitt And in Case my  
 said

Said Stephen shall departe his life before the said Alwerty... hereof shall be set paid or laid out... appoint that the said Alwerty be paid and belong to his sister Mary... and that my said executrix shall lay out the other Alwerty of the said... summe of thirty and eight pounes as my said executrix shall thinke... most fitting for the benefitt and advantage of my said Charles Wittard... and if my said Stephen shall dye before the said last Alwerty or parte... thereof shall be set laid out then I give the said Alwerty to his sister... the said Mary allso or set summe thereof as shall remaine in hand out... as aforesaid then I give and bequeath unto all other my Heiresses... sisters Stephen and Alice the summe of one shilling apiece And all... the rest and residue of my Estate of what nature or kind soever I give... and bequeath to my deare and loving Wife Anne Wittard And I doe... hereby constitute and appoint my said deare and loving Wife the full... and sole executrix of this my last Will and Testament And I doe... hereby revoke all former Wills by me made heretofore declaring... hereby this onely to be my last Will and Testament in wch I have... the said Philipp Wittard have herewith sett my hand and seal this... day and twentieth day of January in the yeare of our Lord... according to the Computation of the Church of England one thousand... six hundred thirtieth and in the second yeare of the Reigne of our... Sovereign Lord and Lady William and Mary by the grace of God of... England Scotland France and Ireland King and Queen Defenders of... the faith of Christ Signed sealed published and declared by... the said Testator to be his last Will and Testament in the presence of... Anne Wittard and Martha Wedde Sam. Thornegood.
